## Faculty Mobility to ISRAEL

### CALL for Applications for Outgoing Faculty/Staff

The EU offers funding for faculty/staff from the University of Innsbruck to spend a maximum of five days (plus two travel days) at one of the below listed academic institutions within the Erasmus+ Mobility Program. Interested faculty can apply until **October 15, 2018** for the Winter Semester 2018/19 and until **December 17, 2018** for the Summer Semester. There are limited spots available. The program includes eight hours of teaching.

**Goal of the Mobility Program:** connect with colleagues and students from the partner institution, establish new collaborations and ideas in teaching and research, enrich the course offerings at the receiving institution, gain experience and bring new knowledge back to the home institution, professional networking.

**Language of Instruction:** English or Hebrew

**Requirements:**

- a. Working contract with the University of Innsbruck
- b. Teaching of at least eight hours in five days
- c. A minimum stay of seven days (including two travel days)

- d. A knowledge of English good enough to teach a specific course (English B2); Hebrew is not mandatory, but basic knowledge is always welcome (courses are offered through the ISI)
- e. Application Form, CV, List of Publications, Course Proposal (complete list see below)

**Teaching:** Faculty should be willing to teach at least an eight hour course that fits into one of the study programs at the host institution.

**Please Note: Course proposals need to be accepted by the receiving institution before the mobility program will be approved!**

**Amount of Funding for one stay:** travel allowance of 360 Euros and 140 Euros per day. All amounts will be paid after return and submission of original bills/receipts.

**Documents Required:**

- a. Application Form, please download via <http://www.aiani.at/erasmus-mobility>
- b. CV written in English
- c. List of Publications
- d. Course Proposal (or syllabus)
- e. Copy of passport [Please note. Your passport must be valid at least six months longer than your projected stay will last]
- g. Language Certificate in English level B2 (if available)

**Selection of Applicants:**

After the deadline, all applicants will be ranked according to academic merit, course proposal, and collaboration outlook. Course proposals need to be approved by the receiving institution. All applicants will get a response about their application within a reasonable time frame (usually 3-4 weeks). After approval, the applicant needs to sign a Mobility Agreement at least four weeks before departure and apply for a "Freistellung" at his/her department.

**Also Needed for the Mobility:**

- a. Valid passport (at least six months longer than the stay will last)
- b. Health/travel insurance

**Application Deadline: October 15, 2018** (for the Winter Semester 2018/19) and **December 17, 2018** (for the Summer Semester 2019) - **Complete Application should be sent to AIANI ([aiani@uibk.ac.at](mailto:aiani@uibk.ac.at)).**
