

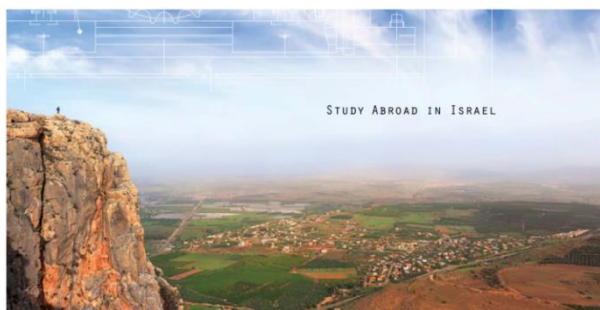
Spend the summer semester

Jerusalem-Galilee Engineers (Summer Semester 2018)

The Jerusalem-Galilee Engineers Program is an innovative program for students enrolled in the technical field or natural sciences (Engineering, Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science etc.). Braude College offers in cooperation with the Hebrew University of Jerusalem (HUJ) a semester-long program in English. The Program starts with a two-week mini-semester at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem where students participate in study tours and in an introductory course in Israeli culture and society. Afterwards, the program continues for 16 weeks (one semester) at Braude College, one of Israel's leading engineering institutions. The campus is located in the city of Karmiel on a hill in the Galilee, a mountainous region in the north of Israel. Braude College works closely together with several high tech companies and students benefit from valuable contacts and practical experiences. Braude College offers students of the LFUI in cooperation with AIANI special scholarships for this program.
