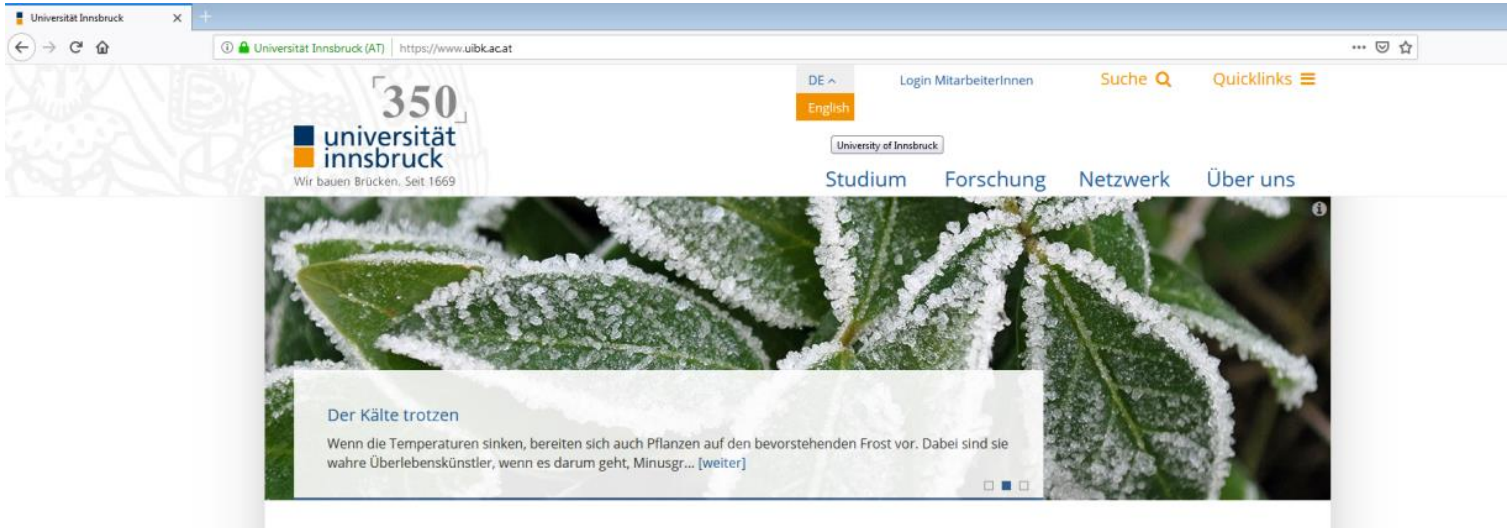
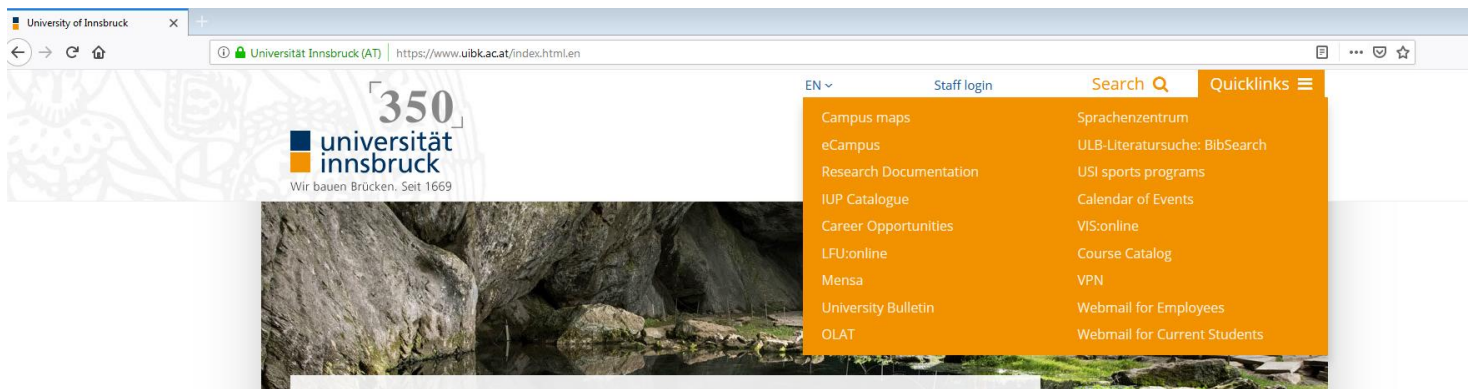

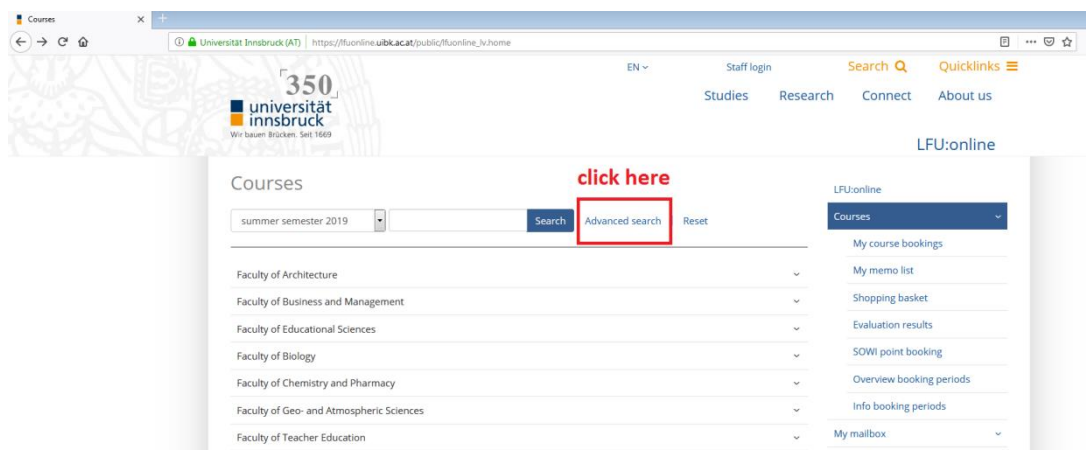
1. Go to the website www.uibk.ac.at and choose the language „English“

Learning Outcome:	The aim of this course is to encourage analytical and close reading While introducing basic conventions of good writing techniques. It is a pre-essay writing course in which students will learn to compose both well-structured and varied sentences as well as coherent paragraphs.
Contents:	A variety of texts on everyday topics, close reading and effective use of dictionaries. a) Sentence level: sentence elements and structure, relative clauses, subordination and coordination, punctuation (commas, colons, semi-colons etc.) b) Paragraph level: unity, coherence, cohesion, content etc.
Methods:	a) intensive study of texts for structural elements, i.e. coherence and cohesion, b) in-class analysis of student-written paragraphs c) simple summaries
